Makaton is a unique communication programme that uses symbols (pictures), signs (gestures) and speech to enable people to communicate. Lots of children's songs and nursery rhymes often include Makaton. We often use Makaton signs in school when learning new songs and supporting our learners with SEND to communicate.




Did you know?

Hearing and vision problems are amongst the most common health issues for school-age children. It is recommended children have their eyes tested every 2 years- is it time your child had a visit to the optician?

Changes to the Neurodevelopmental Assessment Pathway (Previously known as the GDA Pathway)



- The service leading the assessments are RDaSH Children's Care Group Neurodevelopmental Team
- The service is for children who are in Reception through to College age (18 years)
- The new referral process includes a joint Autism and ADHD assessments (Autism from age 5 and ADHD from age 7).
- The process is an education-based referral
- The introduction of neurodevelopmental practitioners/support workers for pre and post diagnostic support

- Mrs Slack and Mrs Eastwood have completed training with our Behaviour Outreach Support Service (BOSS) around the impact of sleep and restorative discussions
