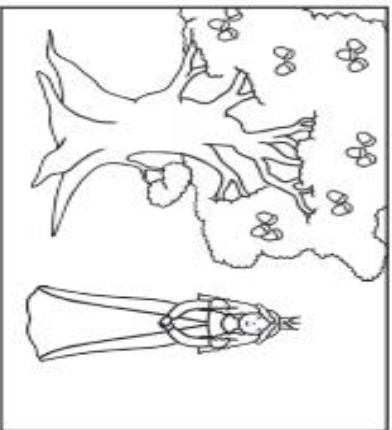
In a park with lots of weeds, stands a big, green tree.



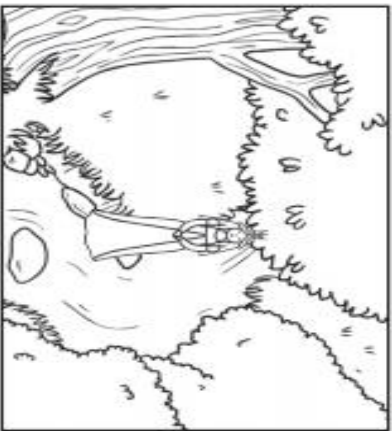

This crow flaps up high. She sees so much below! She sees the farmer mow. She sees her shadow.



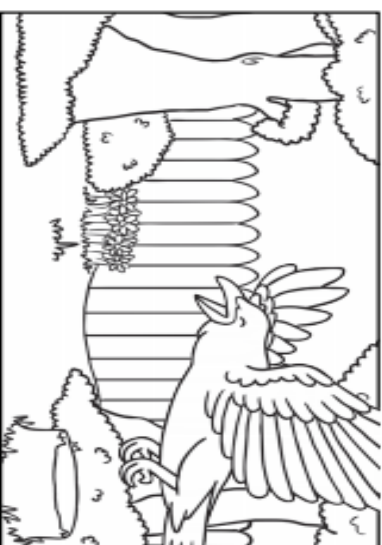
Just then wind starts to blow... It starts to snow! The wind blows the snow and the crow. Oh no!

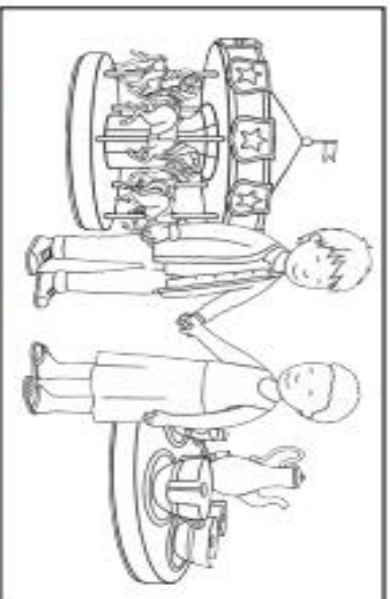
It was hot. Clair sat on a chair to put on a pair of red flip-flops.



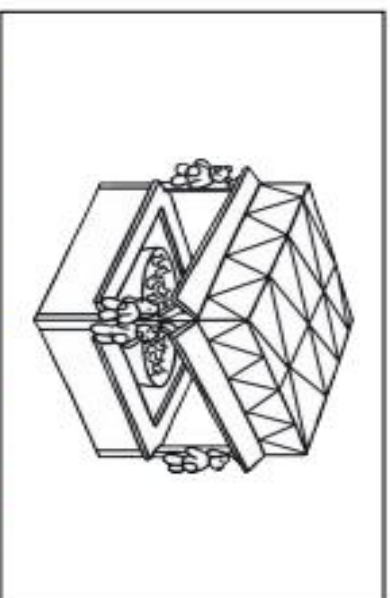
Then, she brushed her short hair and put in a clip.
