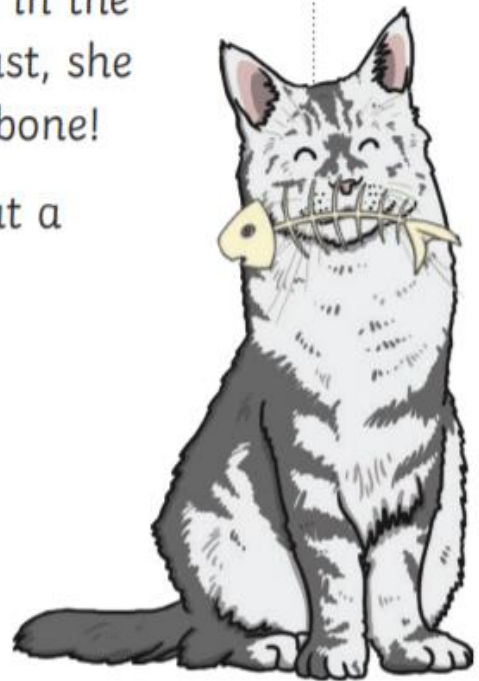
I must tell you all about my cat and her clever nose. She likes to sniff lots of things, like traffic cones, holes in the road and my toes!
