4. Question marks, exclamation marks and commas correctly.

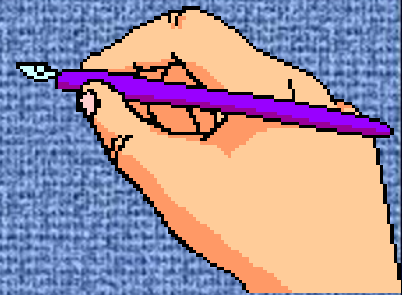

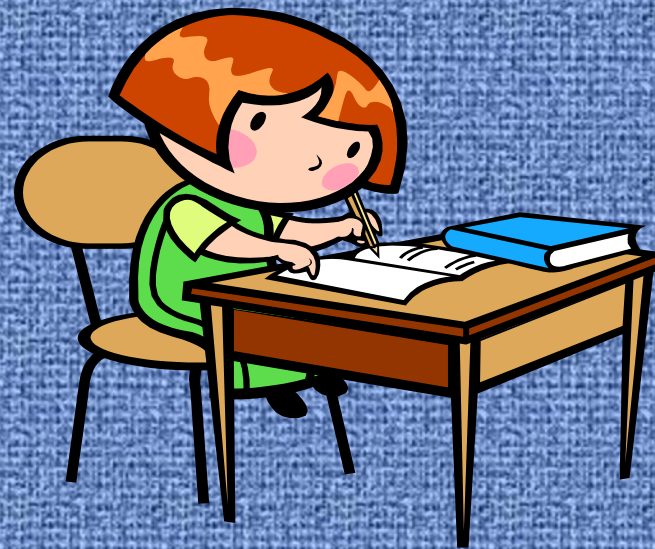
